- Work with participants to develop rehearsal schedule and ensure they know locations and times
- Assist program director with all his needs during class and in preparation
- Attend all classes and functions as the OBF representative
- Disseminate information and handouts to participants and auditors
- Assist class members with their various needs or emergencies and serve as liaison for the class members' needs with OBF staff
